We are surrounded by vast open fields and residential area of Ankushapur village. The population is approximately of 7,645 people residing in about 2,764 houses. Our campus is located amidst open fields with lush greenery in around. The Green Council of Mahendrahills college has played a pivotal role in bringing in the awareness in the entire college to bring the concept of separating biodegradable waste and ensuring the waste to be managed through compost pi near the kitchen garden, monitors scrupulously by the department of Botany and the student volunteers. The responsive and collective investment of efforts have proved to bring optimistic results with respect to the waste management on the campus, alongside the non biodegradable waste management has been sent to the C-MET, where a batch of students have received the C-MET internship program (paid internship) to manage the e-waste and hazardous waste. The Laboratories of the college has also added a great deal of waste management responsibility by discarding the hazardous waste and expired chemicals through proper procedure as directed by the respective councils for laboratory management. Other than the waste management in the laboratories, the students have been initiated to bring in the measures of medical waste management by the Health Supervisor on the campus, whose efforts were equally noted in bringing safe disposal of the biomedical waste. Additionally, the sanitary napkin disposal is been made safe and clear with sanitary pad incinerators, which is the key step in bringing up waste management, suatinable and safe in the campus.
