NSS Programmes



The national service scheme, popularly known as NSS, it was launched on Mahatma Gandhiji's Centenary year 1969. Aimed at developing student's personality through community service. NSS is a voluntary association of young people in colleges, Universities and at +2 levelsworking for a campus – community linkage.

The cardinal principle of the NSS Programme is that it is organized by the students themselves and both students and teachers through their combined participation in community service, get a sense of involvement in the tasks of national building.

Objectives behind the NSS:

- ★ To enable the students to understand the community in which they work.
- ★ To understand themselves in relation to their community
- ★ To identify the needs and problems in the community for the solution of which they can be involved
- ★ To develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility

- ★ To apply their education in finding practical solution to individual and community problems
- ★ To develop competence required for group living and sharing responsibilities
- ★ Gain skills in mobilizing community participation
- ★ To acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitude
- ★ To develop capacity to meet emergencies and national disasters.
- **★** To practice national integration

The main intention of NSS Programme is to change the attitude of volunteers through various activities within the Institution and society. The ministry has framed the following NSS Programmes to give Life Skills Education to the volunteers.

The regular activities should be conducted by every programme officer 120 hours in a year, 100 students will be registering every year as volunteers in this programme.

- 1. Regular Activities
- 2. Special Camping programmes
- 3. Other programmes

1. Regular Activities:

The programme officer has to conduct these activities within the institution 120 hours in a year. There is a misconception that shramadanam, plantation, Blood donation and AIDS Awareness are only the regular activities. But the NSS Program officer can also conduct the other regular activities as per the academic background of the volunteer. The regular activities should be covered Communication Skills, Career counseling, passport taking formalities, Abroad education information, placement information, Legal awareness Law and Order, Global Warming, Supporting to government programmes, health and hygiene. The main intention of these programmes is to identify sincere, disciplined and talented volunteers for state and National level programmes.


2. Special Camping programmes

National unity day-29.10.2022




